Original Certificates to be produced at the time of admission

1. Admit card issued by the NBE/CEE
2. Rank Letter of NEET
3. Provisional Allotment letter – (2 copies)
4. Self attested copy of any Valid ID proof/Aadhaar
5. 10th & 12th Certificates
6. MBBS Degree Certificate
7. Mark lists of MBBS 1st 2nd and 3rd (part I and II)
8. CRRI/Internship Certificate
9. Kerala Medical Council Registration Certificate (KSMC) (Any Medical Council Certificate will be enough at the time of admission. But must submit the KSMC Registration certificate within 1 month).
10. Transfer Certificate (TC) (if the institution does not issue TC, a certificate from the institution mentioning that the same will be submitted on request)
11. Conduct Certificate (taken within 6 months) and Physical Fitness certificate.
12. Proof of reservation Caste / Community / Non-Creamy Layer (if allotted seat comes under reservation category).
13. Income Certificate (if applicable)
14. Nativity Proof (see Clause 4.2 of the Kerala NEET PG Prospectus).
15. Passport size photo (2 Nos)
16. Migration Certificate (For candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the universities other than KUHS)
17. Copy of the Bank Passbook showing account details (Please write name, course, mob number)
18. Equivalence / Eligibility certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur (for candidate who have passed the qualifying examination from the universities other than KUHS). Must submit within 2 months.
19. Bond (Candidates have to execute **two** bonds of **Rs.200/-each**. One bond to the effect that they shall serve the Government of Kerala for a minimum period of 1 year after completion of the course and for paying liquidated damages if they discontinue the course.) Additional 8 green papers sheets for completing the bonds. The bonds should be submitted at the time of admission itself.
20. If the candidate had claimed any fee concession in NEET PG even if their allotment is not in Reservation quota, they must produce the certificate used for claiming the concession at the time of counseling.
21. Students are directed to file online affidavit at <https://antiragging.in> and have to submit the details at the time of Admission (Please see the details in college website). The email received by the student after the successful submission of anti ragging registration has to be forwarded to “antiragginggmcknr@gmail.com”
22. Students are directed to send soft copy of all original documents separately in a PDF format less than 150 kb to admissiongmcknr@gmail.com.
